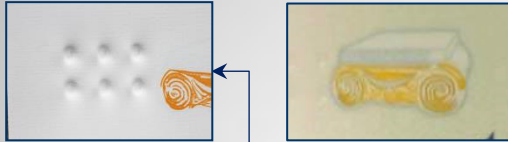




Security features of the banknotes in denomination of 10 Denars – obverse

See-through register

Stylized drawing with a presentation of ionic capital, composed of two different parts (on both sides of the banknote) that complement each other when the banknote is exposed to light.



Sign of recognition

in the form of raised dots to help the blind and partially sighted distinguish between the different banknote denomination.



See-through window

Stylized drawing of a peacock's head which can be seen from both sides of the banknote.



Latent image

The number 10 appears in the pattern beside the peacock, visible only when the banknote will be directly exposed to light.



Security thread

The security thread appears from both sides of the banknote as a dashed line, with clearly written text "НБРМ".



UV-properties

If you look at the banknote under ultra-violet (UV) light you will see that some areas glow.



The banknotes are made of polymer which has a characteristic soft surface



Micro-text

Using a magnifying glass, you will see that some areas of the banknote that look like plain print are in fact very small letters and numbers (in the shadow of the denomination, on the guilloches and above the inscription НАРОДНА БАНКА НА РЕПУБЛИКА МАКЕДОНИЈА).



Security features of the banknotes in denomination of 10 Denars – reverse

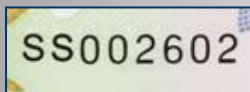
Extra small print

If you look at the edges of the banknote through a magnifying glass, you will see how the text "НБРМ" and "10" repeats itself.



See-through register

Stylized drawing with a presentation of ionic capital, composed of two different parts (on both sides of the banknote) that complement each other when the banknote is exposed to light.



Numeration

Two serial numbers, horizontally and vertically set, which are identical and are composed of two letters and six digits.



See-through window

Stylized drawing of a peacock's head which can be seen from both sides of the banknote.



UV - properties

Micro-text

Using a magnifying glass, you will see that some areas of the banknote that look like plain print are in fact very small letters and numbers (in the shadow and in the design around the denomination).
