See-through register


A portrait of Archangel Gabriel, composed of two different parts (on both sides of the banknote) that complement each other when the banknote is exposed to light.

UV-properties

If you look at the banknote under ultra-violet (UV) light you will see that some areas glow.

Sign of recognition

in the form of raised dots to help the blind and partially sighted distinguish between the different banknote denominations.








See-through window

Stylized drawing of a coin which can be seen from both sides of the banknote.








Latent image

The number 50 appears in the pattern beside the coin, visible only when the banknote will be directly exposed to light.





Security thread

The security thread appears from both sides of the banknote as a dashed line, with clearly written text "HBPM".

Micro-text

Using a magnifying glass, you will see thatsome areas of the banknote that look like plain print are in fact very small letters and numbers (in the shadow of the denomination, on the guilloches and above the inscription HAPOДHA БАНКА НА РЕПУБЛИКА МАКЕДОНИЈА).



Security features of the banknotes in denomination of 50 Denars — reverse

Extra small print

If you look at the edges of the banknote through a magnifying glass, you will see how the text "HBPM" and "50" repeats itself.

See-through register


Numeration

Two serial numbers, horizontally and vertically set, which are identical and are composed of two letters and six digits.
